FAQs About Promotion Ceremony Attire

We are excited to announce that students WILL NOT be wearing gowns or caps and should come to the Promotion Ceremony in professional/semi-formal dress appropriate for an academic ceremony.

Q: Can we wear shorts?

A: No. You should not wear shorts (unless you are wearing them under a dress).

Q: What kind of pants can we wear?

A: You should wear nice pants. Please no jeans (with or without holes), sweats, leggings or joggers.

Q: Can I wear slides?

A: No, you should not wear slides.

Q: Can I wear heels with my dress?

A: Yes you can wear heels but remember you will be walking up and down stairs and across stage, you don't want to trip because your heels are too high.

Q: Do I have to wear a suit?

A: No. Collared shirts, ties and slacks are appropriate; suits and jackets are nice but not required.

Q: How short can my dress be?

A: Dresses should to be mid-thigh or longer.

Q: Can I wear clothing that exposes my mid-drift (stomach)?

A: No. You should not wear clothing that exposes your mid-drift.

Q: Can I wear a t-shirt or athletic wear?

A: No. Students should not wear t-shirts, athletic wear or other informal clothes that would detract from the purpose of the event.

Q: Can I wear a strapless dress or one with spaghetti straps?

A: As a reminder from the packet that was sent home “students need to have a strap or shoulder covering at least two inches wide” and non-plunging necklines.

Q: Am I allowed to wear attire with my undergarments showing?

A: Attire should cover **all** undergarments.

Q: May I wear a lei?

A: Yes.
