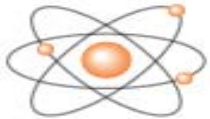

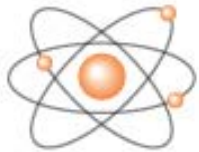


# Bayside Academy

STEM program (6-8) is a fully functional middle school on the East side of campus



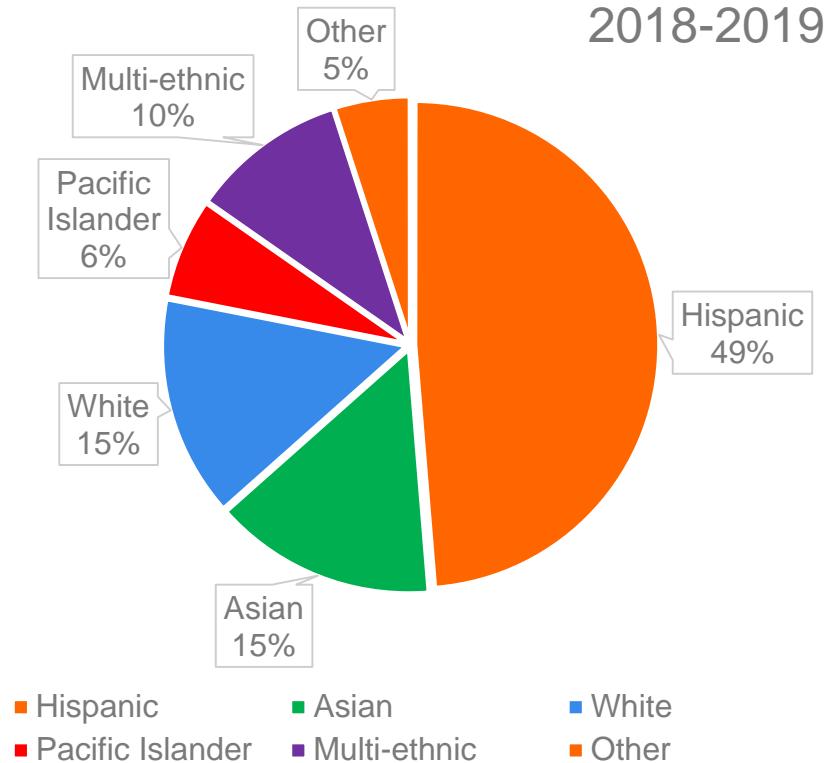
# Bayside Academy Student Population

# Mission Statement

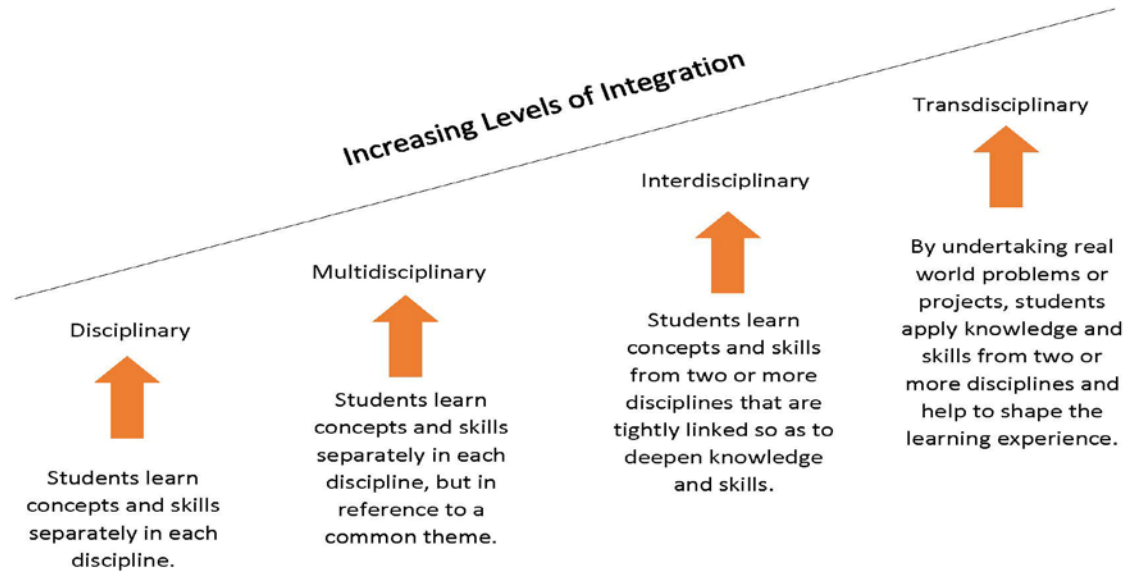

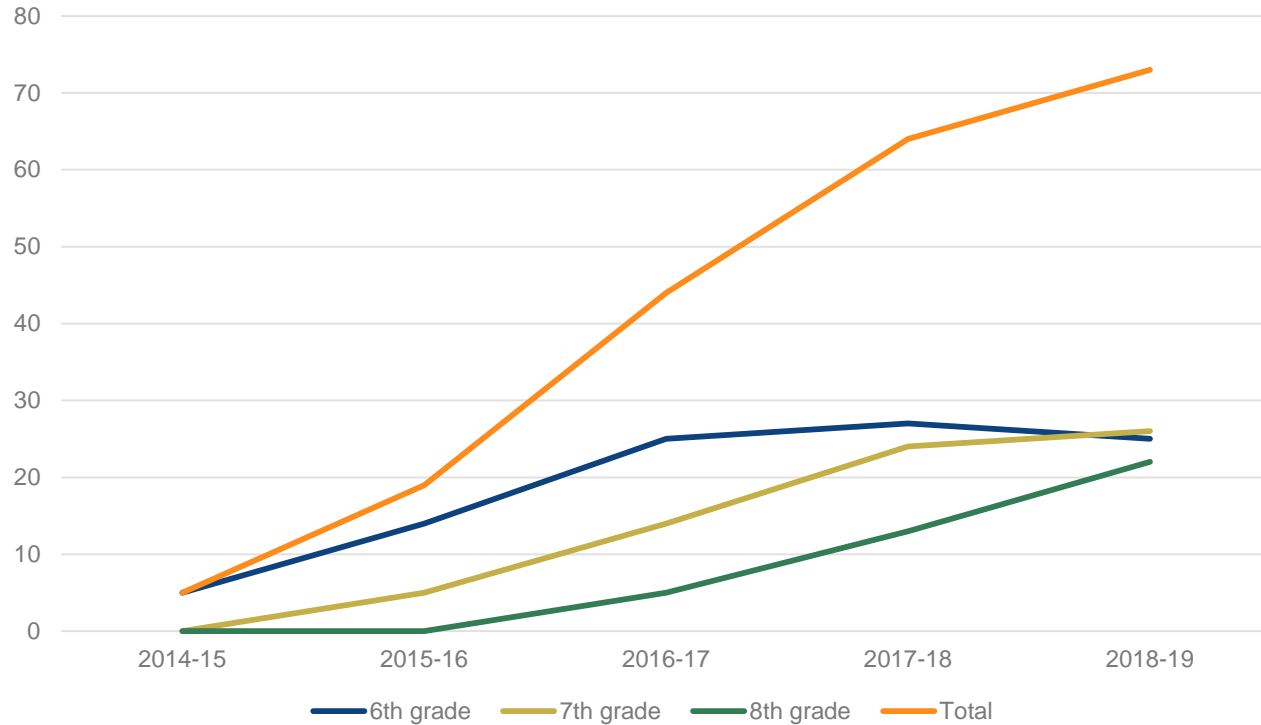

# Student Schedule

All students take 7 classes

**6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> grade:** 2 period of Mandarin, ELA (2 periods), Math, P.E., Science

**8<sup>th</sup> grade:** 2 periods of Mandarin, ELA, Social Studies, Math, P.E., Science

# Student Schedule

Mandarin students are grouped together by grade level for their 2 periods of Mandarin class. Currently, our 6<sup>th</sup> grade Mandarin students are also together for their ELA two period block.

Math, Science and PE classes provide an opportunity to meet other Bayside students.

# Student Schedule - Math

Most students in 6<sup>th</sup> grade take 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Math using the rigorous Common Core State Standards.

*However...*

Some students qualify for the compacted pathway which includes a rich diversity of students.

Invitations to the compacted pathways are based on a series of District criteria.

# How do I apply for Mandarin at Bayside?

1. Once the transfer window opens on **December 3<sup>rd</sup>**, you will apply for a transfer to Bayside Academy in the Mandarin program.
2. Transfer window closes on **December 20<sup>th</sup> at 4:00pm**.
3. Approval letters are emailed home **February 2<sup>nd</sup>??**
4. Once you have approval, you come to Bayside to sign the MOU and complete registration process on either **February 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> ????**
