How it works:

- Showers and laundry are available on a first-come basis. Check in at the Dignity on Wheels table, receive a number and wait your turn
- You have 15-minutes total in the shower stall. **Seven of those minutes is a timed hot shower**, which you start when ready.
- Wash up to 2-sets of clothing only (no shoes, sleeping bags, heavy items)
- Service is primarily for homeless adults, 18-years and older, but may accommodate families under special circumstances and events.
