Dear FGIS Parents/Guardians,

I would like to share with you a summary of three national protests being planned across the country in response to the shooting at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School. Please note that these protests do not represent all of the events that may be scheduled in our community.

March 14<sup>th</sup> - Enough: National School Walkout. Organizers are encouraging teachers, students, administrators, and others to walk out of class for 17 minutes (one minute for each person killed at the school) beginning at 10:00 a.m.

March 24<sup>th</sup> - March for Our Lives protest in Washington DC and other cities, including San Francisco and San Jose. Additional protests might be held in San Mateo County. Organized by students from Parkland, Florida, "March for Our Lives is created by, inspired by, and led by students across the country who will no longer risk their lives waiting for someone else to take action to stop the epidemic of mass school shootings that has become all too familiar."

April 20<sup>th</sup> - National High School Walk-Out for Anti-Gun Violence. Student-organized walkout commemorating the 19th anniversary of the Columbine campus shooting. Some organizers are calling for students to stay out of school until "their demands are met" (ie. gun laws are changed).

Since March 24<sup>th</sup> is a Saturday, we will not be organizing any school events for that day.

I wanted to share this information with you to keep you informed of what may be happening in the community, but also to assure that we will not be discussing these events as part of the school day. For the month of March our teachers will be focusing on The Empathy Tool and discussing Kindness. Teachers will be planning activities that will teach students how we can take care of others and themselves.

These national events were designed to give students, teachers, and others the chance to express their frustration with the senseless gun violence that has already plagued many schools and to take action to bring about change. We support our students' desire to make a positive difference in the world, but we also want to make sure they are safe. As such, we will do what we can to give them opportunities to learn about these issues and explore ways in which they can make a difference.

Estimados Padres/Tutores de FGIS,

Me gustaría compartir con ustedes un resumen de tres protestas nacionales que están siendo planeadas en el país, como respuesta al tiroteo en la Secundaria Marjory Stoneman Douglas. Por favor, tomen nota que estas protestas no representan todos los eventos que pueden ser programados en nuestra comunidad.

14 de Marzo– Suficiente: Abandono Escolar Nacional. Los organizadores están animando a los maestros, estudiantes, administradores, y otros a abandonar las clases por 17 minutos (un minuto por cada persona asesinada en la escuela) comenzando a las 10:00 a.m.

24 de Marzo-- Marcha por Nuestras Vidas protesta en Washington DC y otras ciudades, incluyendo San Francisco y San José. Protestas adicionales se llevarán a cabo en el Condado de San Mateo. Organizado por estudiantes de Parkland, Florida, "Marcha por Nuestras Vidas es creado, inspirado, y guiado por estudiantes del país, que ya no arriesgarán sus vidas esperando que otra persona tome acción para detener la epidemia de tiroteos escolares en masa que se han vuelto demasiado comunes."

20 de Abril – Abandono Nacional de Secundarias Contra la Violencia con Armas. Abandono organizado por estudiantes conmemorando el 19 aniversario del tiroteo escolar en la Secundaria Columbine. Algunos organizadores están pidiendo a los estudiantes que no vayan a la escuela hasta que "sus demandas sean cumplidas" (ej. Las leyes de armas sean cambiadas). Como el 24 de marzo es un sábado, no organizaremos eventos escolares para ese día.

Quería compartir esta información con ustedes para mantenerlos informados sobre lo que está sucediendo en nuestra comunidad, pero también asegurarles que no discutiremos estos eventos como parte del día escolar. Para el mes de marzo nuestros maestros se enfocarán en la Herramienta de Empatía y discutirán la bondad. Los maestros planearán actividades que les enseñará a los estudiantes como podemos cuidar a los demás y a nosotros mismos.

Estos eventos nacionales fueron diseñados para darle a los estudiantes, maestros y otros la oportunidad de expresar su frustración ante la violencia de armas sin sentido que ya ha asediado muchas escuelas, y a tomar acción parar lograr un cambio. Apoyamos el deseo de nuestros estudiantes de hacer un cambio positivo en el mundo, pero también queremos asegurarnos que estén seguros. De tal formas, haremos lo posible para darles las oportunidades de aprender sobre estas cuestiones y explorar maneras con las que pueden hacer una diferencia.

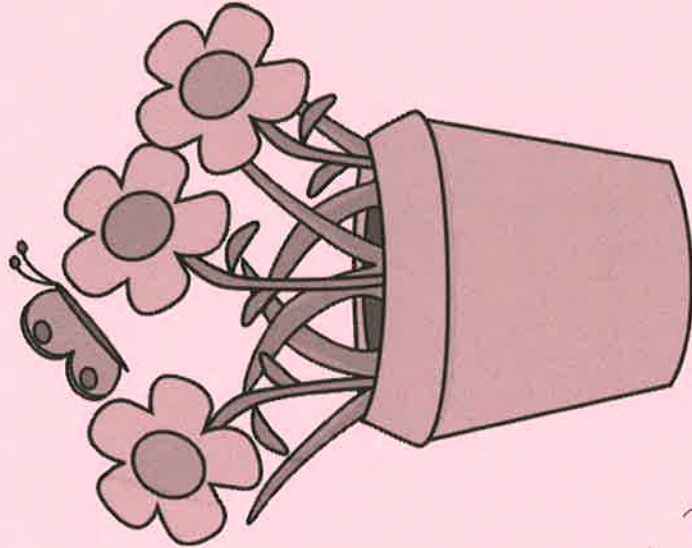
