Poster Making (Optional)	Friday, October 26 and Monday, October 29 at lunchtime
Poster Campaign (Limit of 7 posters per candidate)	Tuesday, October 30th to Thursday, November 8th
Speech Approval	Thursday, November 1st and Friday, November 2nd at lunchtime
Present a speech at the school's assemblies	Thursday, November 8th (twice)
Student Voting	Right after the assembly
Announcement of Student Council Members	Friday, November 9th at the end of the day
