Dear Audubon Families,

On Wednesday the SMFC Board of Trustees determined that reopening in the Hybrid Model for elementary and SDC students should occur **after San Mateo County returns to the Red Tier**. Here are some details:

- Students will not change classes/teachers on January 19, 2021 as originally proposed. Class changes are now determined by when San Mateo County returns to the Red Tier. Class changes will take effect after returning to the Red Tier. We will be in communication with you if this happens. In the meantime, students will stay with their current teacher until further notice.
- Reconfigured class assignments for elementary and SDC students will be sent to families on Friday, December 18, even though the class changes will not go into effect until we reopen in the Red Tier.
- Students will remain with their CURRENT TEACHER when they return from Winter Break.
- Travel notice--students who travel more than 150 miles from their homes must quarantine for 2 weeks before returning to campus. This will not affect students who are in Distance Learning and do not come to campus; they would continue to join their virtual classes on-line. This would only affect students in the hybrid model once we reopen the campus to them.
