Dear Audubon Families,

We want to start by celebrating the amazing students who participated in the Audubon Talent Show last Friday. Thank you to all the participants who shared their talents and brought us great joy! We also would like to thank the PTA Talent Show Committee for putting together this wonderful event. In today's communication, we'll be sharing about the May 3 Reopening, the Fall Selection Survey, Teacher Appreciation Week, and Wednesday PD Day.

May 3 Reopening

Pending approval from the School Board on April 28, students who are currently in Hybrid two days per week will move to five days per week and students currently in Full-time Distance Learning (FTDL) whose families selected in-person learning in the parent survey earlier this month will also return to campus on this 5-day schedule starting May 3. Students whose families elected to remain in FTDL will continue in FTDL through the end of the school year. Any additional class/teacher changes will occur on May 3. Families will be notified of reopening class assignments on Tuesday, April 27, by 4:00 PM. All students will remain at Audubon when we reopen with the exception of TK students who have requested in-person learning.

We'll be sending out additional communications this week to share with you the latest updates, including the new in-person bell schedule. On Wednesday, April 28, from 3:00-4:00 PM, we will be holding a PrinciPALS' Chat for families transitioning to in-person learning. Reopening Timeline

- Tuesday, April 27 - Families notified of classroom assignments.
- Wednesday, April 28 - Wednesday PD day (see below for details)
- Wednesday, April 28 from 3:00-4:00 PM - PrinciPALS' Chat for families transitioning to in-person learning.

- Thursday & Friday, April 29 & 30 - Asynchronous learning days ONLY for students in classes whose teacher is transitioning from FTDL to In-person instruction. Your teacher will let you know if these days are asynchronous.
- Monday, May 3 - Return to five days of instruction per week for all in-person students.
