School Materials Drop-off/Student Personal Items Pick-up

On Monday, June 8, the campus will open for the purpose of returning textbooks, library books, 5th grade instruments/music books, and other school materials. Please do not return Chromebooks/hotspots, even if your child is moving to middle school, unless your child will not return to the district in the Fall. During this time, personal student items may also be picked-up. We'll send out more detailed information next week. Here are a few highlights:

- The window to assess campus will be from 9:00-12:00 PM on Monday, June 8 by last name.
- Although we miss our students tremendously, for safety reasons we asked that children not come to campus. Please only send one adult from each family.
- On this day, June 8, teachers will not be holding virtual meetings or providing lessons. Instead, a menu of activities will be posted on GoogleClassroom for students to choose from. Shhhh...don't tell the teachers, but some of these activities include creative ways to say "thank you" to them as well as their supporters at home.
- During June 2-5, teachers have been provided one full day or two half days to prepare for "Drop-off/Pick-up." Your teacher will let you know which day or half day they will be prepping.
