- Student support meetings such as an IEP, SST or 504 meetings will continue through teleconferencing.
- Child nutrition will provide "grab and go" meals from Monday, March 16 through Friday, April 3, from 11:30 am - 1:00 pm at four school sites: College Park Elementary School, Laurel Elementary School, Lead Elementary School and Foster City Elementary School.
