

# GEORGE HALL COVID TESTING

August 30, 2021

Dear George Hall Families,

I am excited to let you know that we will have on-site walk-up COVID testing available

**Wednesday 1:00pm-8:00pm.**

Our school has partnered with **Virus Geeks** to make this happen, and we are hoping to have this option available to our families more regularly, so stay tuned! The test will be a molecular PCR test and results will be available after 24-48 hours. During registration, you'll select how you want to be notified (eg text vs email).

## **Below are some details:**

### **Who:**

- Parents, children, and all staff are welcome to get tested here on site.

### **When:**

- 1:00-8:00 on Wednesday September 1
- **If you are bringing your child directly after pickup, please wait patiently in line, as this will likely be the busiest time of the day.**

### **Where to come:**

- LGI entrance on Curtiss. Please line up along the sidewalk on Curtiss near the gate.
- Please maintain social distance between families who are in line.

### **What to prepare:**

- **Please go to <https://my.virusgeeks.com/testreg> and register each person in your family prior to coming. You do not need to schedule an appointment.**
- Once you register one person in your family, there will be an option to register other family members.
- If you already went to the San Mateo Marriott drive-up that Virus Geeks runs, you can use your name and date-of-birth to pull up your account. If you visited other Virus Geek locations you will still need to register.

### **What to expect:**

- Families will enter into the LGI from the LGI Gate entrance on Curtiss and exit the LGI from the side of the building.
- When you are at the testing station, parents/guardians will administer the sterile swab at the bottom of each nostril of the child.
- Families will be at one station together. Please make sure that the children stay with the adult they arrived with and at the testing station they've been assigned to once inside the testing area.
