Goal during Distance Learning

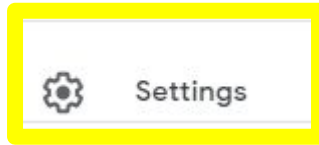
- Distance learning can not nor intended to replace brick and mortar school

2. Scroll down to settings



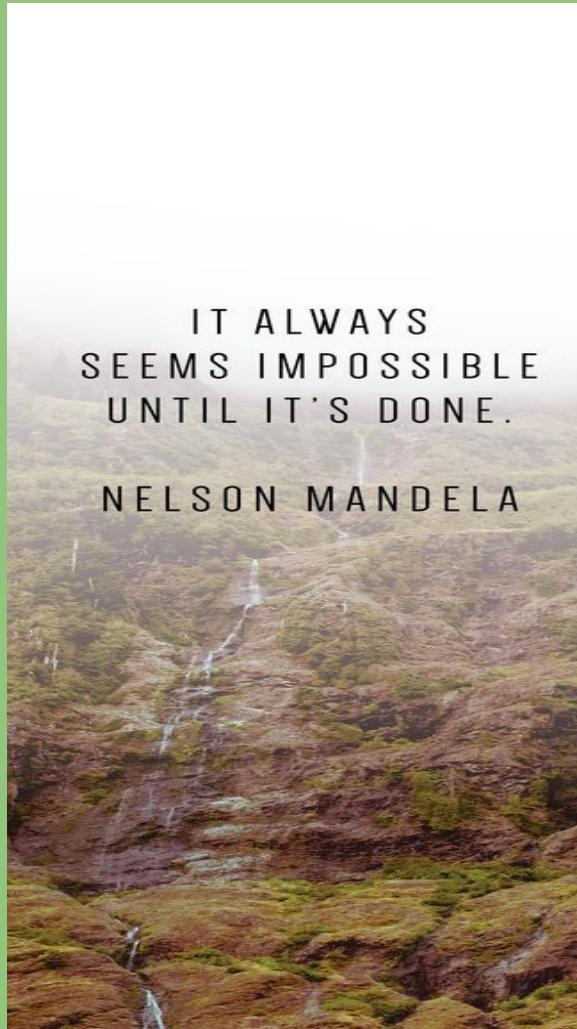
3. Go to email notifications
